Artist Chuck Cave will present a slide show and talk highlighting Howard Finster's Garden of Revelation. The Gardens were begun in 1961 by Howard Finster, a preacher, who was inspired to create "sacred art" using recycled materials. He used bottles, glass, mirrors, bathtubs, toilets, garbage, plastic, bicycle frames, etc, etc, etc. His work has been featured at the Library of Congress and the Smithsonian. He has been on the front page of the Wall Street Journal and interviewed on the Johnny Carson show. The four acres site in Georgia attracts thousands of visitors a year. This unique lecture will explore one man's spirituality through making things with what others would consider junk.

Chuck Cave is an Emeritus Associate Professor of Art at Penn State University. He taught printmaking and bookmaking. His books and prints are held in numerous collections, including the British Museum, Library of Congress, the Chicago Art Institute, Victoria and Albert Museum and the Nelson-Atkins Museum of Art.
